Formal Session: A 50-minute presentation in a classroom setting on a music-related topic. Topics to consider include (but are not limited to): composition, technique, repertoire, collaborative performance, business policies, or other studio and performance-related topics that address the needs and interests of music instructors. To apply, please submit via e-mail:

1. A Microsoft Word document containing:
 - a) Presenter's information (name, phone number, e-mail)
 - b) 70-80 word bio
 - c) Session Title (in its final form) and Session Abstract (not to exceed one page)
2. Your photo (not to exceed 1.5 MB in size), attached as a file to the e-mail and not embedded in the e-mail body.

Poster Presentation: A visual presentation of information for display. Authors present and describe the work, provide handouts, and answer questions at the designated Poster Session times. Typical categories include (but are not limited to): research, studio/pedagogy projects, and practical teaching information. May 1, 2017: Poster Session submissions
